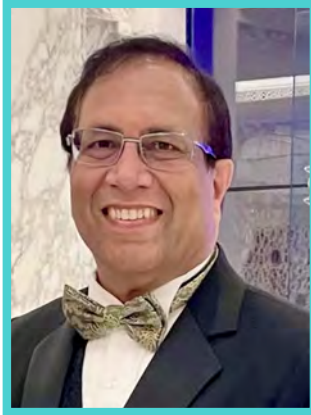

MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT / HINDI TRANSLATION

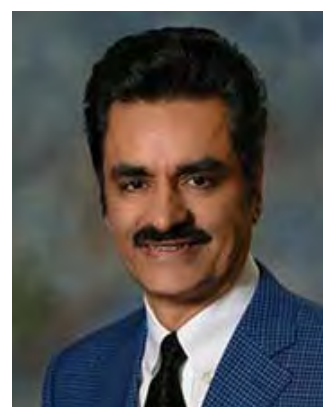

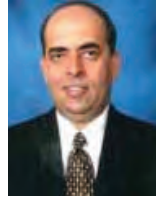

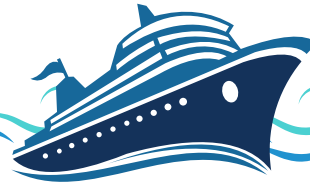

In Memory of Our Dear Friend Dr. Subhash Jain

Our beloved friend, colleague, and past RAJMAll president and founding member Dr Subhash Jain, passed away last year on November 17, 2023. We honor his memory at this year's annual convention.

Subhash was born in 1946 in Jodhpur, Rajasthan as the second son of Champalal and Kesar Bai Jain and married to his dear wife Sarla (Duggar) Jain in 1968. After graduating SMS Medical College and working as a rural physician in Mandoli and Banswada, Rajasthan, he made the difficult decision to immigrate to the US, training in anesthesiology and pain medicine at New York Hospital, Cornell University College of Medicine (now NYP/Weill-Cornell).

Over the following years, he would build a life in the metropolitan New York area and establish himself as a foremost global authority in the management of pain, proudly founding and leading the pain service at Memorial Sloan Kettering Cancer Center for over 20 years. An endowed lecture is held at Sloan-Kettering annually in his honor. To say he was a master clinician would be an understatement. In the words of one of his patients, Dianne Capraro, "Dr. Jain was absolutely gifted in the ability to eradicate pain in his patients. There is no other doctor as compassionate and dedicated to helping his patients find relief and to regain as much of a normal life as possible."

Subhash was a dedicated member of our profession and mentored countless Indian immigrant physicians, many of them members of the RAJMAll community. He also proudly gave back to healthcare and education efforts in Rajasthan through the charitable trust he led, International Human Benefit Services. He was also a leader in the North American Jain religious community, having worked with others to establish key organizations in support of the Jain faith..

By profession, he was a healer. But his passions extended to music, poetry, spirituality and, most importantly his family and his friends-with a particularly special place in his heart for fellow Rajasthani physicians in America. He was the revered patriarch of a family that includes his wife Sarla and his children-Narpat/Archana, Roopam/Sapna, and Sachin/ Jennifer-and grandchildren-Sidharth/Aashi, Rishab, Sambhav, Aadesh, and Parshav.

The Jain family thanks the RAJMAll family for its friendship an help in remembering Dr. Jain's towering legacy and presence over our community.

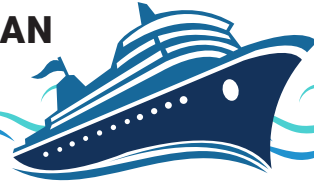



Dr. Ranjana Desai, Principal and Controller of Dr.S.N. Medical College and attached Hospitals, Jodhpur, Rajasthan



If a name could personify compassionate leadership and unwavering dedication, it would be Dr. Ranjana Desai. Since January 2024, she has served as Principal and Controller of Dr. SN Medical College and its associated hospitals in Jodhpur. Her journey from student to head of her alma mater has been defined by resilience, growth, and continuous learning.

Dr. Desai, born on August 18, 1962, to Dr. Madan Mohan Sharma and Anusuya Sharma. She excelled academically and in sports at Saint Patrick's School in Jodhpur. She competed nationally and at the state level in softball and volleyball and is also an accomplished Kathak dancer, demonstrating her artistic talents.

Dr. Desai entered the medical field after ranking 5th in the Rajasthan Pre-Medical Test in 1979, choosing Dr. SN Medical College in Jodhpur. Following her father's footsteps, an Associate Professor in Pathology, she embraced values of humility, dedication, and personal responsibility, shaping her professional and personal life.

During her MBBS studies, Dr. Desai earned three gold medals and the Maharana Bhim Singh Award for General Proficiency in Final MBBS, awarded by the Governor of Rajasthan in a state ceremony.

Post-graduation, Dr. Desai specialized in Obstetrics and Gynecology under Professor Dr. Chandra Kiran, who taught her to learn from each patient. "Every patient is your book—take the time to learn from them." This philosophy enhanced her clinical skills and patient management during her residency.

Dr. Desai's dedication went beyond medical skills; she embraced personal sacrifices, managed stress, and showed empathy during patient hardships and triumphs. Her commitment to compassionate care, inspired by Dr. Kiran's teachings, highlights her leadership and patient-centered approach.

Dr. Ranjana Desai began her medical career as an Assistant Professor at RNT Medical College, Udaipur, in February 1991, and continued there from August 1991. She is married to ophthalmologist Dr. Sanjiv Desai, and they have two daughters: Devanshi, an ophthalmologist, and Urvashi, a skilled computer scientist.

In 2015, Dr. Desai became Head of the Department of OB/GYN and Superintendent of Umaid Hospital, the largest women's hospital in Western Rajasthan. By 2023, she was the longest-serving Superintendent in Rajasthan. Her leadership led to major improvements, including color-coded bed sheets to prevent infections and renovations of wards and the High Dependency Unit. Under her tenure, Umaid Hospital received the "Laqshay" Certification and the national Lakshya Award for its labor room and operation theatre complex.

Under Dr. Desai's leadership, the hospital NICU won the first prize for best neonatal services in Rajasthan. She also improved maternal health by distributing Non-Pneumatic Anti-Shock Garments in rural Thar regions, along with training for doctors and paramedics, significantly reducing maternal mortality from post-partum hemorrhage over the past five years.

Dr. Desai's academic achievements include 30 publications on early cancer cervix detection. Her research on adapting surgical microscopes for colposcopy earned her the Gargi Devi Shurveer Singh prize and the national FOGSI-CORION award.



While serving as Superintendent of Umaid Hospital, Dr. Desai was also appointed Additional Principal of Dr. SN Medical College, where she enhanced the College library and improved convocation management. 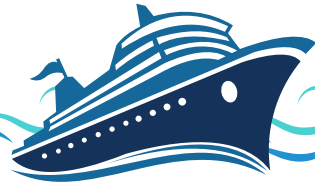

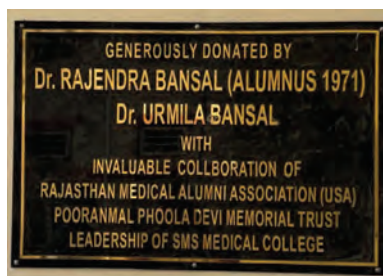

Samín K. Sharma, MD, FACCD, MSCAO

Samín K. Sharma, MD, is a renowned interventional cardiology expert well known for performing high-risk complex coronary interventions (more than 1,500 interventions per year) with an extremely high success rate (greater than 99 percent) while achieving an extremely low major complication rate (less than 0.2 percent). He has received the prestigious two-star designation (significantly lower than expected mortality) numerous times from the New York State Department of Health, and the Governor's Award of Excellence in Medicine in 1996. He served on New York State's Cardiac Advisory Board from 2004–2016.

Under Dr. Sharma's leadership, The Mount Sinai Hospital Cardiac Catheterization Laboratory has become one of the safest and busiest centers in New York, providing state-of-the-art cardiac and interventional care for all types of simple and complex heart patients. Dr. Sharma specializes in the nonsurgical treatment of mitral and aortic valve disease, including transcatheter aortic valve replacement (TAVR) and MitraClip™ procedures (TEER). He has been dubbed "master of the Rotablator" and is regularly featured on national and local TV (recently on CBS, TV Asia), and in newspapers and magazines including Newsday, Newsweek, The New York Times, The New York Post, Forbes, The Wall Street Journal, The New York Daily News, The Washington Post, New York Magazine, India Abroad, and India Today. He has received numerous awards: 2023 Master Operator by India Live Conference, 2021-2022 Chief Guest, Times Square, Diwali Celebration; 2018 Chairman Board of Trustees, Association of Indians in America (AIA); 2015 Honorary Master of Science PhD degree by Rajasthan University Jaipur India; 2014 Distinguished Physician Scientist by AAPI-QLI for excellence in Medicine; 2011 Ellis Island Medal of Honor; 2011 American Heart Association Achievement in Cardiovascular Science & Medicine Award; 2011 American Association of Physicians of Indian Origin (AAPI) Physician of the Year; 2010 AIA for Excellence in Medicine; 2003–2007 and 2010–2023 Best Doctors by New York Magazine; 2008–2023 Super Doctors; 2007 Jacobi Medallion Award by The Mount Sinai Hospital; 2007 Physician of the Year by The Mount Sinai Hospital and 2000 Simon Deck Award for Outstanding Teacher of the Year.

He has authored more than 360 papers and 16 book chapters in the field of coronary interventions, structural heart disease and safety of percutaneous interventions. He is also a philanthropist, and The Mount Sinai Hospital Cardiac Catheterization Laboratory is named the Dr. Samín K. Sharma Family Foundation Cardiac Catheterization Laboratory. Dr. Sharma has been instrumental in getting a \$5 million philanthropy grant from the Lohia Family to name him Director of the newly created SP & Seema Lohia Cardiovascular Clinical Institute. Dr. Sharma has built a 250-bed heart hospital (EHCC) in his native Jaipur, India, to provide the best care to all patients irrespective of their financial and social status. To expand medical reach to more needy patients in Jaipur, EHCC now has two additional hospitals (Eternal Hospital Sanganer and Jaipuria Hospital). His live monthly webcast series, CCC Live Cases (www.ccclivecases.org), started in 2009, and has an audience of more than 25,000 viewers each month in 179 countries.

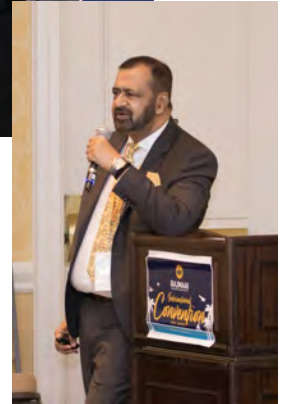
He also enjoys teaching other cardiologists and improving patient outcomes with his annual Complex Coronary Cases (CCC) Symposium and numerous other major scientific meetings, conferences, and live relays. He is also the Director of the Top Ten Topics in Clinical Cardiology Course every Fall and the NY Transcatheter Valves Symposium every December.

Rajendra Bansal - Physician, Successful Businessman, and Philanthropist

Raj, an alumnus of SMS Medical College Jaipur (1971), left India in April 1978 for Zambia, leaving the MD course in its very year. From there, he passed the UK exams and moved there. In 1984, he moved to the USA to complete his residency and thereafter settled in Jupiter, Florida, a suburb of West Palm Beach, a place where Donald Trump visits most weekends, as does a large contingent of the famous

and wealthy.

After leaving SMS Medical College, Dr. Bansal was a Registrar in Coronary Care Units in the UK. He finally moved to the USA, where he finished his Internal Medicine training at Wayne State University Detroit. There, in 1988, he started to practice as a board-certified Internist. At Jupiter Medical Center, he was the youngest Chief of Medicine (1993-94), Chief of Staff (1995-96), and Member of the Governing Board till 1997. He gradually metamorphosed into a businessman as he saw his future in private companies and insurance. Over the years, he has supported several organizations, including RAJMAI, through donations. As of now, his wholly-owned ventures include:

1. Medical Services Organization - It gets subcontracts from Private Insurance companies to reduce cost of treatment and takes all the financial risk. The savings are shared by all the service providers (physicians) Insurance companies and his MSO-Health Promoters. This is his main business.

2. Jupiter Medical Group - Dr Bansal established 13 Primary Care Practices with 103 providers. It provides Primary care services. He sold Advantage Plan MSO with 103 providers and 54 affiliated Centers.

3. Imaging Centers - Four such centers provide imaging services, including MRI, PET Scan, PET Stress, CT 64, Cardiac CT, US, Nuclear imaging, Digital X-ray, and 3D Mammograms.

4. Staffing Services - It provide staff Radiologist and Pathologist at Hospitals

5. Drug and Alcohol Rehab Centres - Three of such centers are in operation at the moment. These are In Patient facilities with 30, 58 and 110 beds.



6. Real Estate Commercial business.

Success is never unidirectional and is always mixed with failures. Raj is no exception. He suffered huge losses as he expanded his insurance business to include other physicians. He also ventured into the restaurant business, but it always made losses. Failures didn't despair him, albeit he has learned his lesson. From here on, he started focusing on his core expertise areas. He closed all his restaurants and made Insurance Business shine again. His wife, Son and Daughter are now all in family business.

7. Accountable Care Organizations - Already operational in South Florida, it has enrolled over 300 Primary care physicians and 500 Specialists. It saves costs with Quality care. The profits are distributed to all physicians. These are with our other colleagues Rohit Dandiya and Subodh Agarwal. The National Success rate is only 26%, but their 4/4 are all successful. Three more are in the making in different parts of the USA. Palm Beach Accountable Care Organization (ACO) is a group of hospitals, doctors, and other healthcare providers in Palm Beach County. It is drawing national attention to the successful cost savings it has generated. ACOs are groups that voluntarily come together to decrease costs while maintaining the standards of quality care and patient satisfaction.

The Palm Beach ACO (PBACO) is an exclusively physician-owned and operated organization started in July 2012 as a Medicare Shared Savings Program (MSSP) by Dr. Arthur Hansen, Dr. Rajendra Bansal, and Dr. Leonard Sukenik. According to Physician CEO Dr. Hansen, "The physician members of PBACO are a group of forward-thinking and dynamic people that have come together into a like-minded group that is an integral part of historical change in our Country's healthcare." Under Dr Bansal's leadership, PBACO is The highest-ranked ACO, with five other ACOs in 13 other states.

PBACO includes primary and specialist care physicians coordinating collaborative healthcare to achieve the optimum outcome. There are 240 Primary Care Physicians and 150 Specialist Physician Members in PBACO and over 62,000 Medicare lives.

"It's easy to cut costs by reducing services, but PBACO's philosophy is to improve quality outcomes with appropriate health care, more communication, and physician cooperation," says Hansen.

Dr Rajendra Bansal contributed significantly to the Rajasthan Medical Alumni Association, RANA, and several other organizations in the USA. On the 75-year platinum jubilee of Alma mater, he donated a reading hall with a library to SMS Medical College, Jaipur.

His proactive approach led to the establishment of Rajasthan's first private ambulance service in 1988, a pioneering move that addressed the issue of service availability. This was followed by the launch of the first private blood bank in 1995, the first nursing school in 1998, and the first government-approved private paramedical college in 2005. His significant contribution to the field of blood banking was recognized with an award from the Governor of Rajasthan on Republic Day 2001.

In 2015, Dr. Agarwal was unanimously elected as the National President of the Indian Medical Association. The President of India nominates him as a governing body member of the Indian Red Cross Society. The Government of India also nominates him for the Governing Body of AIIMS Jodhpur and the Ministry of Home Affairs in the National Foundation of Communal Harmony. He was a member of the National Blood Transfusion Council, the Ethics Committee of the Medical Council of India, the Central Council of Health & Family Welfare, and the National Board of Examinations.

Dr. Agarwal was appointed Director (AIDS) of Medical & Health Services By the Government of Rajasthan, Medical and Health Services.

Throughout his career, Dr. Agarwal has remained steadfast in his vision of providing quality healthcare at an affordable cost. This dream took shape in 2003 with the initiation of the RHL Project, a significant step towards realizing his vision. In 2015, he, along with his colleague, Dr. Virendra Singh, brought this vision to life with the dedication of Rajasthan Hospital (RHL) to the people of Jaipur & Rajasthan. Dr. Agarwal collaborated on new projects at SMS Medical College and Hospital, including the establishment of the Reading Hall Library, Sports Complex, E Studio, and cafeteria for medical students and residents. These projects have a lifelong impact on the history of SMS Medical College, Jaipur.

Throughout his life, Dr. Shyam Sunder Agarwal has repeatedly displayed exemplary efforts, inventive vision, and immense dedication to making the society around him a better place for future generations.

Darkness prowls like a silent thief in the land of vibrant colors and golden sands. Rajasthan, where every sunrise paints the horizon, also hides a shadow—a mighty shadow cast by the high prevalence of blindness. I invite you to join me on a journey to unveil our tenacity, hope, and healing story as we battle blindness amongst the poorest of the poor in Rajasthan.

Blindness Looms Large in Rajasthan

India has the largest blind population in the world. Truth be told, one-third of the world's blind people call India their home, and this has been the situation for several decades now. It's a poignant tragedy that, within the country, Rajasthan has the unfortunate distinction of having the highest prevalence of blindness. In actual numbers, it's a huge figure estimated to be in millions. The backlog keeps increasing despite the huge number of cataract surgeries done by the government and NGOs like us.

Nexus between Poverty and Blindness

Traditionally, our beloved Rajasthan has grappled with poverty for long. According to the 2023 report released by Niti Aayog on the national Multidimensional Poverty Index (MPI), Rajasthan ranks as the second poorest state in the country, with 29.5% of its population falling into this category.

Messiah of the Blind

My father, Professor Dr. NC Desai, a visionary in the field of ophthalmology, led the charge against blindness in Western Rajasthan. After completing his FRCS from Edinburgh, he dedicated himself to government medical services. Over time, he ascended to Professor and Head of the Department of Ophthalmology at Dr. S.N. Medical College in Jodhpur. Upon retiring in 1980, Dr. Desai's commitment intensified, and his post-retirement years became an active phase of service. Fueling his passion for free eye surgery, he established the Smt. Tarabai Desai Charitable Ophthalmic Trust - a public charity named in honor of his mother - registered under the Devsthan Act.



Miracle of Sight

Community-based eye care services in an eye camp, which results in a patient's restoration of Sight, can have a miraculous effect on a person and the person's personality. It significantly improves the quality of the individual's life. It allows them to perform daily tasks independently, enhances safety, and nurtures social engagement. Whether performing a task, recognizing faces, or navigating surroundings, restored vision empowers people to regain autonomy and participate fully in their world as wage earners and valuable members of society.

Over the past 44 years, our unwavering commitment to eye care has left an indelible mark on the lives of countless individuals, with more than 100,000 successful eye surgeries performed,

Recently, we achieved a groundbreaking milestone—the world's first pediatric cataract surgery using a photochromic intraocular lens. This innovative procedure promises brighter futures for young patients, allowing them to experience the world in vivid hues with lifelong safety and protection.

USA INCOME TAXPAYERS WITH FOREIGN ACTIVITIES/

US Taxpayers Report Worldwide Income:

Under the current United States (US) tax law, US taxpayers are obligated to report and pay taxes on their worldwide income, not solely limited to the income earned within the borders of the United States. This principle is known as “worldwide taxation” or “global income taxation.” It means that regardless of where the income is generated, whether from foreign employment, investments, rental properties, or any other source, US citizens and resident aliens are required to include all such earnings in their annual tax return. To avoid double taxation, the US provides various tax credits and deductions for foreign taxes paid. This approach ensures that US taxpayers fulfill their tax obligations on a global scale and prevents the potential hiding of income or assets in offshore accounts. Compliance with worldwide income taxation is an essential aspect of the US tax system, promoting fairness and transparency in the taxation of its citizens and residents.

Definition of “US Taxpayer”:

A US taxpayer refers to an individual, entity, or business that is subject to the United States tax laws and is obligated to file and pay taxes to the US government on their income, profits, or other taxable activities. For individuals, a US taxpayer typically includes United States citizens, permanent residents (Green Card holders), and certain non-citizens who meet the criteria (Physical Presence Test) of a “resident alien” for tax purposes. Additionally, US taxpayers can encompass corporations, partnerships, limited liability companies (LLCs), and other legal entities that conduct business within the United States or have income derived from US sources.

Foreign Filings and Disclosures:

In addition to regular income tax filings, US taxpayers with activities in other countries may need to file additional forms and/or disclosures related to those foreign assets or activities. Failure to file or report required information could result in substantial penalties. Some of the more common required filings and disclosures related to foreign activities and assets include, but is not limited to, the following:

Report of Foreign Bank and Financial Accounts (FBAR)/ FinCEN Form 114

A US taxpayer that has a financial interest in or signature authority over foreign financial accounts must file an FBAR if the aggregate value of the foreign financial accounts exceeds \$10,000 at any time during the calendar year.

Form 8938 - Statement of Specified Foreign Financial Assets

This form is used to report specified foreign financial assets if the total value of all the specified foreign financial assets in which the US taxpayer has an interest is more than the appropriate reporting threshold.

Form 5471 – Information Return of U.S. Persons with Respect to Certain Foreign Corporations

Certain US taxpayers who are officers, directors, or shareholders in certain foreign corporations file Form 5471 and related schedules to satisfy the reporting requirements for their interests in certain foreign corporations.

Form 5472 - Information Return of a 25% Foreign-Owned U.S. Corporation or a Foreign Corporation Engaged in a U.S. Trade or Business

US taxpayers typically file Form 5472 if they are a 25% foreign-owned US corporation or a foreign corporation engaged in a US trade or business, and they need to report certain transactions with related parties.

ASSETS TO REPORT WORLDWIDE INCOME

Form 3520 - Annual Return to Report Transactions With Foreign Trusts and Receipt of Certain Foreign Gifts

US taxpayers typically file Form 3520 to report certain transactions with foreign trusts and receipt of large gifts or inheritances from foreign individuals or entities.

Please note that each forms has its own penalty between \$10,000 to \$25,000. If fails to file respective above Forms when due and in the manner prescribed.

Sale of Foreign Property or Assets:

For US taxpayers, it's essential to be aware that selling property or an asset outside of the United States doesn't exempt that person from reporting this income on their US tax return. Even if they've paid taxes on the sale to the foreign country, the United States adheres to a policy of worldwide taxation, requiring you to disclose all income earned, regardless of its origin, which includes the sale of property and other assets located outside the US.

The common misconception that foreign taxes paid automatically absolve you from reporting in the US can lead to serious tax compliance issues. To ensure full compliance with US tax laws, it is crucial to include the foreign-sourced income from the sale of any property or asset on your US tax return.

However, you can utilize the foreign tax credit to offset some or all of the US tax associated with this foreign-sourced income, helping you avoid double taxation and reducing the overall tax burden. To claim the credit, US taxpayers can complete Form 1116 with US tax return filing, which calculates the eligible credit amount based on your foreign income and US tax liability. The credit is generally limited to the lesser of the foreign taxes
